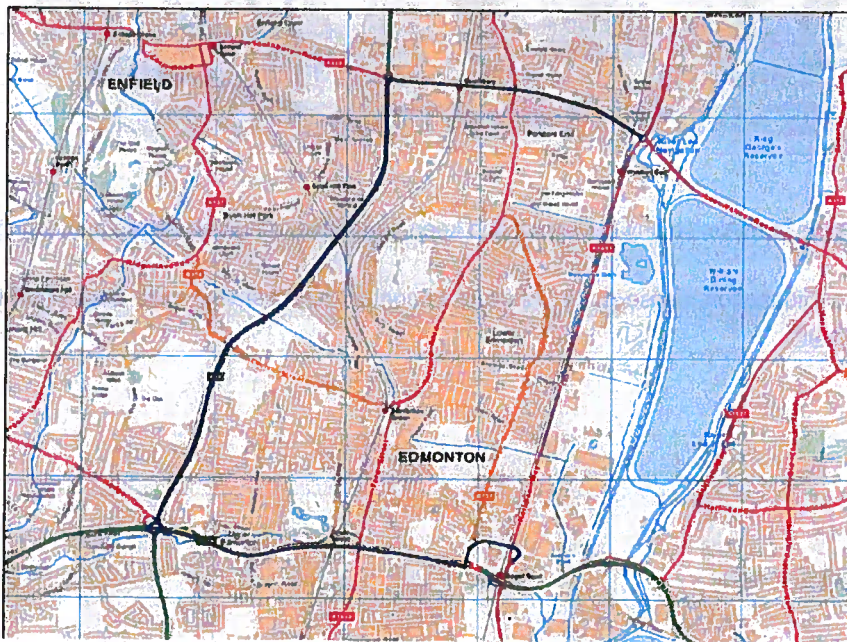
Ardra Road

UK Power Networks own and maintain underground electricity cables and overhead lines, and we have a new supply scheme proposed in your area. The project involves the installation of high voltage electricity cable via open excavations. The overall route will run from our substation located opposite Sedge Road, through Meridian Way, into Ardra Road.

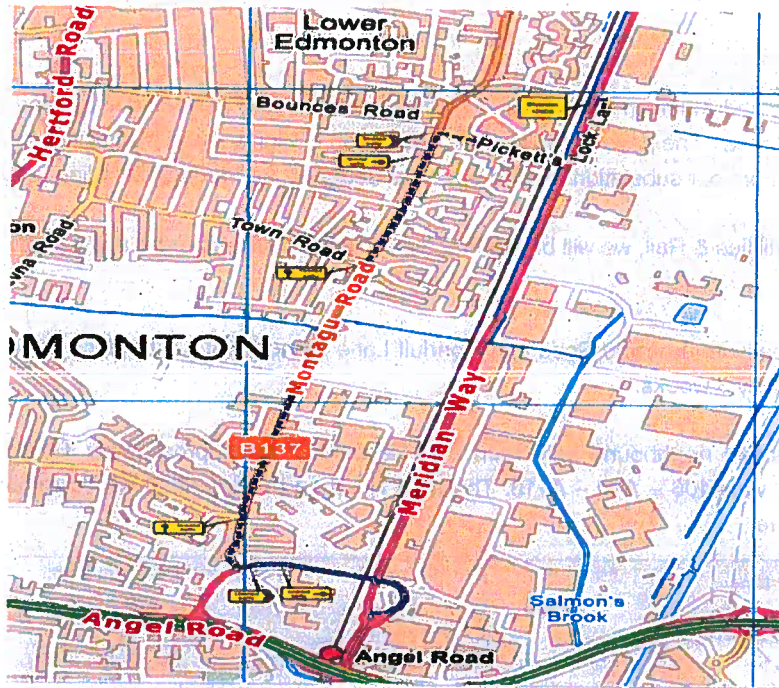
In partnership with Kier Utilities & Rail, we will be starting the project in September for approximately 7 months.

Works in Meridian Way between Leaside Road and Conduit Lane roundabout will be done under lane closures from 4th September for approximately 3 weeks.

Meridian Way will be closed northbound only from 20th September for approximately 14 weeks. The diversion for northbound traffic will be via A406 – A10 – A110. Thornton Road and Ardra Road will therefore have “No Right Turn” imposed during the closure.



The northern section of Conduit Lane/Meridian Way roundabout will be closed overnight only from 6th November for one week. Road users will be diverted via Conduit Lane - Montagu Road – Picketts Lock Lane – Meridian Way.



We will do everything possible to minimise any disruption and keep you further informed before and during the work.
